## EYE CLINIC



Thanks to ChristWalk Church of Amelia Island, Florida and The Rock Church of Jonesboro, Arkansas whose combined contributions have enabled us to begin construction of an eye clinic. The building is well underway and is expected to be completed before the end of this year, 2008. The eye clinic is located next to the dental clinic, in Bethany Village. The eye clinic will accommodate surgical and diagnostic units. Construction requires a lot of water. Well, we normally get city water once a week; however we have gotten water only twice within the last 6 weeks. Using one of the BUV's Moses has been going to the nearby river and transporting enough water, so that construction has been continuing without delay.


## WIDOWS
