tes has become more prevalent in Ghana in recent years. Many people are not aware of this disease and how fatal it can be if not monitored. Of course, for most people it will be the first time in their lives to have this test done. As with all our services, this is another opportunity to share the gospel of Jesus Christ with those who have not heard.

GENERATOR, EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES



Reliable electrical power is essential to good health care. We had prayed and hoped to purchase a power generator for our new mission base for some time. Last May 2021 the Lord provided the funds to acquire a very good power generator. This generator is twice the capacity of the one at our Ghana base. The capacity is enough to power both clinics and the whole mission base. We are thankful to the Lord and to those through whom He provided this essential equipment. In addition to the generator, we also received numerous donations of dental chairs, instruments, an autoclave, an ophthalmic microscope, slit-lamp and other equipment and

supplies for the dental and eye clinics we are establishing in North Africa. Lord willing we will ship a 40 ft container to North Africa during the month of September. This area is an unreached territory; and we are excited to bring the good news of salvation through Jesus Christ to this part of the world. We thank God for the favor He has given us to be able to accomplish what He has called us to do.

We humbly ask for your continued prayers for those

who will hear and accept God's plan of salvation.
